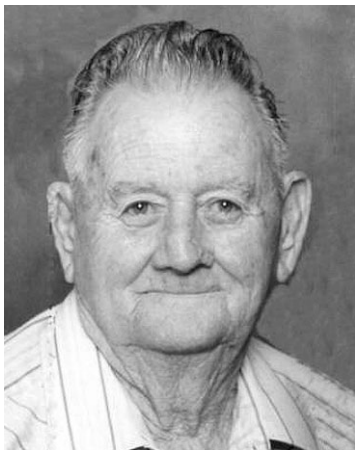


## LEON GALLOWAY
